SECTION 1: GENERAL

- Teamsheets on club headed paper must be signed by the referee prior to the commencement of games
- Teamsheets must be signed by the Club Runai, leas Runai, or the designated person notified by the club, to the Divisional Bord to manage the team
- Teamsheets (Servaport team sheets to be used) must include the following
- Name of the players in Irish
- Croke park registration for each player

- Date of Birth for each Player
- Players numbered 1-15, and pro rata for games of lesser sides otherwise it will be assumed that the first 15 and pro rata are playing
 - All Mentors to wear official Bibs For Semi Finals and Finals .Max 5 mentors per team
- Team Officials Details

Penalty for non compliance: Fine €50.00

SECTION 2: PREMIER U13 PLAYING RULES

1) VENUES

- a) Shortened Pitch 13M to 13M for Group A, B
- b) Shortened Pitch 13M to 13M For Group C,
- c) Shortened Pitch For Group D 21M TO 21M
- d) Goalposts to be centred on D at 20M Line, D must be Marked

2) GAMES Players in Grade A, B, C, & D must be over 10 years on January 1st (born 2008, 2009& 2010 & 2011)

- 1. Groups A, B,
 - a. 13 aside competition.
 - b. 13 aside Competition
 - c. 11 aside competition
 - d. 9 aside competition
 - e. Substitutions Unlimited Roll On Roll Off Referee to receive sub slips
 - f. Injured Players may be replaced.

Penalty for non compliance: Forfeiture of Game e

3. General U 13 Games Regulations

- a. Four steps one touch four steps strike or kick
- b. Goalie can take kick out from the hand.
- c. 45 to be taken off the ground.
- d. No solo in hurling. [one touch only]
- e. In the event of clash of colours, **both teams change**, unless there is prior agreement notified to the secretary of Coiste na nOg **Penalty for breach of regulation €100 fine**.
- f. Square ball as per Official Guide (Rule 4.9 T.O 2020)
- g. The Mark shall be in force as per Rule 2.12 TO 2020)
- h. In hurling all 65s from the 65M line.
- i. In football 45's from the 45 M line from the ground.

- j. In Hurling and Football, (*Player make take 4 steps then a touch and 4 more steps before striking or kicking*)
- k. In football no dribbling
- 1. In hurling all puckouts in front of the posts, max 4 paces from goal line.
- m. In football kickouts can be taken from the hand from inside the "D"
- n. No player is permitted to pick the ball from the ground except Goalie
- o. All Knockout games must finish on the night, bar the finals, games level on score at fulltime will play the following extra times
 - i. U13: 2 X 5 Minutes per side

(if still level after extra time) replay and must be finished on day if still leval after extra time first score wins

- p. No Forward mark
- q. Black Card allowed 5minutes sin bin

3) TEAM NUMBERS.

- 1) Team sheet to be numbered from 1 to whatever number of subs on panel. If this rule is breached the team forfeits the game, first Thirteen players to wear jerseys accordingly ie 1 to 13 in Group A, Group B 1 to 13, Group C 1 to 11, Group D 1 to 9
- 2) , subs to wear 14 onwards Group A,14 onwards in Group B ,12 onwards in Group C, 10 onwards in Group D
- 3) All teams in U13A are made up of Minimum 13, the match will be forfeited If the club cannot field 13
- 4) U13B will be Minimum 13. the match will be forfeited If the club cannot field 13
- 5) U13C will be Minimum 11 the match will be forfeited If the club cannot field 11
- 6) U13D will be Minimum the match will be forfeited If the club cannot field 9
- 7) For clubs with more than one team the first 13 have to be registered with their divisional Coiste na nOg registrar at least **48 Hours** before the first fixture or by the date specified by the Divisional Coiste na nOg and County BNG Secretary
- 8) For Clubs with second teams no under 13A/15A players not allowed play 15C/U15D/17C

4) TEAM SHEETS

- 1. 2 official Team sheets have to be provided at each match.
- 2. Teams sheets must be for the team registered with Registrar, any player not present must be crossed off and the replacement player written underneath
- 3. Teamsheets must include the following

Name of the players and mentors in Irish

Players Date of Birth

Croke park registration number for each player and mentor

Players numbered 1-15, and pro rata for games of lesser sides otherwise it will be assumed that the first 15 and pro rata are playing

Teamsheets must be signed by the Club Runai, leas Runai, or the designated person/mentor notified by the club, to the Bord to manage the team (Rule Official Guide)

Penalty for breach of Regulation €50.00

SECTION 3: Under 13, 15 & 17Knockout Competitions:-

1. General

1. All Fines must be paid within 14 days of official notification of imposition by Runai CCC

2. Venue

- 1. All Championship matches will be at venues approved by the CCC
- 2. Juvenile Secretary at neutral Championship venues will be responsible for I. Pitches must have goal nets and be flagged and lined
 - II. Grass must be cut to an acceptable level, particularly for hurling **Penalty for breach of regulation €20 Fine**

3. Games

- 1. In the event of clash of colours, both teams change.
- 2. Penalty for breach of regulation €100 fine.
- 3. All 15A/15B Championship games will be 15 aside, .C will be minimum 11 a side, .D will be minimum 9 a side
- 4. All 17 A &B Games will be 15 aside, C will be a minimum 11 aside
- 5. All Championship games (County Bye-law), games level on score at fulltime will play the following extra time.
 - a. U13 A TO H 2 X 5 Minutes
 - b. U15 A & H 2 X 10 Minutes
 - c. U17 A & H 2 X 10 Minutes
 - d. Replay if still level and if still level after extra time next score wins
- 6. Games must start at the appointed time as there may be extra time
- 7. Teams who have not taken the field 15 minutes after the appointed start time shall forfeit the game.
- 8. For all semi finals and finals, the secretary of the competing clubs shall forward to the secretary of Coiste na nOg, Thursday before weekend fixture, or otherwise stipulated by Coiste na nOg, their team line out for match programme. Finalists shall line out their teams as numbered on match programmes. Penalty for breach of regulation €50 fine.
- 9. For clubs with more than one team in a grade, the first 15 and subsequent 15 / 11 players, have to be registered with their divisional Coiste na nOg registrar at

- least **48 Hours** before the first fixture or by the date specified by the Divisional Coiste na nOg and copied to County BNG Secretary
- 10. For Clubs with second teams no under 13A/15A players not allowed play 15C/U15D/17C
- 11. U 15 C Competition minimum 11 a side.
 - U 15 D Competition minimum 9 a side
 - a. Shortened width by 7 Metres in from each side
 - b. If both teams have available players clubs on mutual agreement can agree to play 13 aside on full size pitch.
 - c. Players cannot score directly from kick out / puck out
 - 12. U15C ,U15D and U17 C competitions are run by County Coiste na nOg entry fee to these competitions are 100 euro
 - 13. Walkovers in under 15c, 15d and 17c will carry a fine of 100 euro

4. Alterations to fixtures

- 1. Divisional competitions shall be finished in time for the playing of the county semi-finals to be decided by the Coiste na nOg. If a division has not its competitions finished in time for the playing of the county semi-finals by the specified dates, it shall nominate teams to represent the division in these games.
- 2. Alteration to Fixtures shall be at the discretion of Coiste na nOg. Teams must agreed alternative fixture to be played before original fixture and fixture must be ratified by CCC. (Semi Finals only)
- 3. No alteration shall be permitted to County Final Dates unless in exceptional circumstances
